

## Commencement Speaker & Honoree

*Amenah F. Pangandaman*

Secretary of Budget and Management

As the Secretary of the Department of Budget and Management (DBM), Amenah F. Pangandaman offers diversity and fresh perspective to an otherwise male-dominated team of economic technocrats.

A Maranao with roots from the south, Pangandaman always aims to give Mindanao a voice in her capacity as a public servant in the different branches of government. Having served in the Legislative, Executive, and in the central bank, she has a unique perspective on the Philippine bureaucracy and a deep understanding of the interplay among the different sectors and agencies in the economic sector.

Prior to her appointment as the Secretary of Budget and Management, Pangandaman served as the Concurrent Assistant Governor for Strategic Communication and Advocacy and Executive Offices Coordinator. In that capacity, she was a key implementor of the Bangko Sentral's strategic initiatives aimed at bringing the central bank closer to the Filipino people. She also championed financial inclusion and digital transformation, and steered the execution of major projects supporting the Governor's goals within and outside the halls of the BSP. With her extensive experience in the Legislative branch, she likewise advocated for enactment of the BSP's priority legislative measures.

Pangandaman is not new to the budget process. She was Undersecretary at the Department of Budget and Management during the Duterte Administration. Acting as the functional group Head of the Office of the Secretary, she directly supervised the Department Liaison Office and Budget Technical Bureau. During her stint at the DBM, she pushed for crucial budget reforms and was a key mover in the preparation, implementation, and monitoring of the General Appropriations Act. She also oversaw the implementation of Green, Green, Green—a budget assistance program for local government units to develop sustainable public open spaces. Prior to her appointment in the DBM, she oversaw the enactment of budget laws as the Chief-of-Staff to Former Senate President Edgardo J. Angara and Committee of Finance Chairperson Senator Loren B. Legarda.

Upon assumption as the chief of the budget and management department, Pangandaman vows to support the incoming administration's mission towards a broad-based and inclusive economic recovery, bringing the Philippines back on track to achieving a high-middle income status. In this line, she aims to pursue prudent management of the government's fiscal resources, the modernization of the budget system, incorporation of sustainability and green principles in government spending, and finally, the promotion of sustainable economic growth through strategic investment in high-impact infrastructure and human capital development.

She has a degree in Economics from the Far Eastern University, a diploma and master's degree in Development Economics from the University of the Philippines, and is currently pursuing her Executive Master of Public Administration from the London School of Economics.

Abdul Rashid “Elian” R. Macala is a highly accomplished entrepreneur and public servant dedicated to economic development and community building, particularly in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM). His extensive experience spans over two decades in public service, beginning in 1996, and includes significant leadership roles in both the public and private sectors. He has served as Regional Governor of the Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry - BARMM, Vice Chairperson of the BARMM Business Council, and Representative for the Business Sector on the Regional Peace and Order Council - BARMM. Additionally, he's held the position of Chairman and President of the Bangon Marawi Chamber of Commerce and Industry, and served as a Regional Board Governor for the Board of Investment - ARMM (now BARMM). His earlier public service roles include Municipal Planning and Development Officer and Planning Officer III in the Office of the President, Malacañang Palace.

Mr. Macala's business acumen is evident in his leadership of the Macala Business Group (MBG), a diverse enterprise operating across Mindanao and BARMM. MBG, with its various PHILGEPS Platinum-certified businesses, encompasses fuel stations (Soti Fuel and Phoenix Gasoline), logistics (Lanao Cargo and Logistics), construction materials (ARM Enterprises), agricultural products (Macala Enterprises), food and beverage (Torogan Kape), retail (Soti Mart), and real estate (Lindongan Subdivision). He also heads the Soti Foundation, Inc., a Muslim charity organization. He successfully managed the DTI National Kabuhayan Project for Marawi Siege Victims and oversaw the COMELEC National Election's distribution and delivery of election paraphernalia throughout Mindanao. His numerous awards and recognitions reflect his significant contributions. He is a three-time Highest Contributor of Business Tax in Marawi City, a top Withholding Taxpayer for the Bureau of Internal Revenue, recipient of the Most Outstanding Young Chamber award from President Rodrigo Roa Duterte, and the Outstanding Cooperative award from President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo. His academic achievements include a Master's in Entrepreneurship from the Asian Institute of Management, a Bachelor of Laws from Mindanao State University, and a BSBA in Accounting from the same university.
